We'll have a medic on site all weekend, a gluten-free dinner option, and the party is all ages, all night! Thank you for being a part of the tournament and making it so memorable. Be fun, be safe, and have a great weekend!

Parade of Nations

The Parade of Nations returns this year so all teams can come and show off and **admire all the costumes**. The parade will be Saturday morning before the first round (before they get trashed) at **8:20am** at Frisbee Central. It will last approximately 20 min so get there dressed and ready to put on a good show. We will have signs with your team's name to hold during your procession, and a photographer to capture the moment. Come prepared to **cheer, heckle, and get your swag on!**

Health and Safety

We will have a professional medic on-site all weekend. In the event of an injury or illness requiring medical attention, send runners to Frisbee Central to alert the medic. The nearest hospital is Kadlec Regional Medical Center, located at 888 Swift Blvd. in Richland (3.4 miles south on George Washington Way, then turn right on Swift Blvd.).

Tournament Setup and Rules

36 teams are placed into nine pools organized into three tiers. Each team will have three pool games, one cross over game, and one bye on Saturday. The rounds will be 90 minutes with ten minute breaks. There is less daylight in the fall, so begin your games on time and listen for the hard cap. Games are played to 13 on both Saturday and Sunday, win by two. Mirror halves. One timeout per half plus a floater. We'll be using 11th edition rules with Callahan defensive goals and a 20 yard brick. All fields will be 70 x 40 yards with 20 yard end zones. Gender mix is four-three, however, be nice to teams with fewer women. Offense calls the ratio.

- 1) Saturday has 9 pools set up for competitive games for all teams based on your self-ranking.
- 2) You will play all teams in your pool and one cross over game.
- 3) A summary of your field assignments by round is shown after your team name on the schedule.
- 4) Sunday bracket play has three divisions, with Saturday pool winners being promoted up a bracket, and pool losers being relegated down a bracket.
- 5) Everyone is guaranteed a minimum of two games on Sunday. Top four seeds in each bracket have a first round bye. Brackets will be posted at the party, posted on Facebook, and e-mailed to captains.
- 6) We will supply score sheets at the Captains' Meeting.

1 blast from the horn signifies the start of the round

2 blasts means hard cap (finish the point and the game is over; unless tied, then play one more)

As we are on school district property and in a public space there are rules which must be followed. We have previously had some trouble with garbage.
